TOWARDS ZERO WASTE STRATEGY HAS BEEN LAUNCHED!





MICDA has released the Towards Zero Waste Magnetic Island Strategy 2025–2030.

The plan sets a bold target to divert 80% of the Island's waste—around 500 tonnes annually—from landfill by 2030, cutting about 960 tonnes of CO2 emissions each year, equal to 3.9 million car kilometres.

Developed with community input and supported by the Australian Government's Reef Trust and Great Barrier Reef Foundation, the strategy outlines 61 actions, from boosting organics recovery to supporting local businesses. The initiative will protect the Reef, create jobs, and help Magnetic Island become a leading sustainable reef island.

The Strategy aims to dramatically decrease the amount of waste sent to landfill, leading to significant environmental benefits & improvements in sustainability practices across the Magnetic Island community.

By implementing the Towards Zero Waste Strategy, Magnetic Island can reduce landfill waste significantly, reducing GHG emissions through waste reduction, associated energy actions & decreased transport movements.


